PROTO FASTFACTS™

In Service: 1946-early 70s; several preserved.

Variations: Most built to run long-hood forward. Some equipped with steam generators for passenger service. Railroad-specific appliances.

Primary Assignment: Road freight and secondary passenger service; later used as yard switchers. Many "retired" units sold to industrial and shortline operators.

History: RS-2 production began in 1946 and just over 350 were built through 1950. Over the next two decades, RS-2s worked for Class I, shortline and industrial operations across the continent and one survivor still holds down daily freight duties in 2007. A few others serve museum lines.
