In Service: 1918-1950s

Variants: Numerous changes made to tenders and appliances after end of USRA control in 1920; copies built through early 1950s.

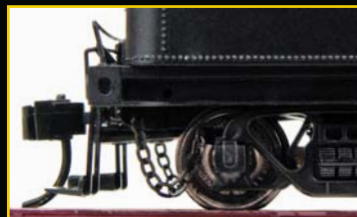
Primary Assignments: Yard switching and transfer service, also used as industrial switchers.

By 1917, the arrival of larger and much heavier freight cars had pushed most 0-6-0 designs to their limits. Realizing that railroads needed more powerful switchers, the United States Railway Administration developed plans for an all-new 0-8-0. Up-to-date in all respects, these big switchers were the equals in power of many road freight locomotives from just a few years earlier. The USRA 0-8-0 was well liked by railroads that received it and 175 were completed before government control ended in 1920. More success came in later years, as 35 different roads eventually copied the design. In fact, the last new steam locos built in the U.S. were a series of 0-8-0s, constructed by the N&W in 1951-53 that followed the general outline of the decades-old USRA design.
