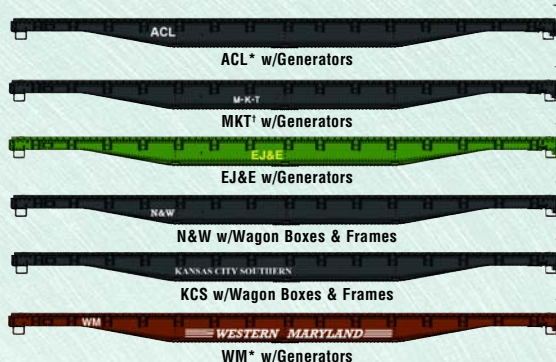

#### PROTO FASTFACTS™

**In Service:** 1940s-80s; some still in work train service.

**Primary Use:** Cargoes too large or difficult to load in boxcars; many later modified for piggyback and lumber service.

In 1941, the Union Pacific began upgrading its fleet with new 53'6" steel underframe flat cars. Later adopted as an American Association of Railroads (AAR) standard, hundreds were built and served into the 1980s, with a few still in work train service today.
