

# Item No. 433-1331 ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

## NATIONAL OIL CO.

#### **BEFORE YOU BEGIN, READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY!**


Read each step thoroughly before attempting to complete it. Study the diagrams and locate where various parts will be needed. The part numbers are indicated on the sprues. (Sprues are the rods to which the parts are connected.)


If you want to customize your building with paint, determine which parts will need to be painted BEFORE assemby. Find the parts on the sprues, and decide whether it will be easier to paint them on or off the sprue. If the parts can best be painted off the sprue, remove them carefully with a hobby knife and make a note of the part number so you can identify the part when assembling it.

Use watery styrene cement, applied sparingly, to assemble this building. Use sandpaper or a file to roughen a surface that is resisting the cement.

### 1 • oil pipe & railings

- 1. Cement the oil pipe to the front tank support. (Fig.1)
- 2. Cement the two short railings to the platform . (Fig. 2)
- 3. Now cement the two long railings to the platform, and to the short railings as shown. (Fig. 2)






#### 2 • tank structure

- 1. Cement the 2 tank halves together
- 2. Cement the 2 short tank supports to the base.
- 3. Cement the front and rear tank supports to the base and to the short tank supports.
- 4. Cement the underframe to the tank.
- 5. Now cement the underframe to the tank support.


**NOTE:** make sure the platform locating ribs on top of the tank are facing to the right as shown!

6. Repeat steps 1, 2, and 3 from this section to form the second tank structure.



### 3 • assemble the building


- 1. Cement the 4 building walls to the larger tank base. Match up the numbers at the corners. (Fig. 4)
- 2. Cement the 2 roof panels to the walls and to each other.
- 3. Cement the vent stack to the roof.
- 4. Cement the footing to the base.



#### 4 • finished structure

- 1. Attach the pre-printed color decals to each tank.
- 2. Cement a callbox to each power pole, and a pole to each base.
- 3. Cement a platform support to the footing on each base.
- 4. Cement a platform to the tank and to the support on each structure.
- 5. Cement a ladder to the base and to the platform on each structure.
- 6. Cement the barrel ends to the barrels.
- 7. Cement the barrels, tools, lumber stacks and pipe sections to each base. You may use the photo on the box as a guide.

NOTE: Tank structures may be positioned on your layout together, as shown, or separately.
