These new cars were designed as a single level car primarily for eastern routes due to tunnel clearance issues. Production units were built by Amerail/Morrison-Knudsen and entered service in 1995. The cars feature roomettes, bedrooms and an accessible bedroom with space for a wheelchair or mobility device. Still in service today, they're easily spotted by their double row of windows.

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EMD SD70, SD70M, SD75I Locomotives

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Featuring all new tooling, accurate dimensions and many roadname specific details, the WaltherMainline SD70/SD70M and SD75I locomotives are sure to become the favorite motive power on many modern-era H0 scale railroads. This new run marks the debut of the SD70 "Spartan Cab" and some SD70M commemorative paint schemes to the WaltherMainline roster.

The prototypes for these models were first built in the early 1990s by the Electro Motive Division. With some examples still going strong today, the 4,000-hp SD70M is a hardworking thoroughbred of 21st century railroading. It remains part of the backbone of many class I railroad fleets. The SD70M variant features a wide North American style safety cab, while the 4,300 hp SD75I an isolated or WhisperCab for added crew comfort denoted by the prominent gasket between the nose and cab.

Many other variations are captured in the WaltherMainline H0 scale models, as outlined below.
