From raw materials to finished goods to scrap metal, the steel industry has long been big business for railroads. One of the workhorse freight cars of that rail-served industry is the 65' mill gondola. First built in the 1940s, these mill gondolas served into the 1970s and beyond.

Based on a Thrall mill gondola design, the WaltherProto model is accurately sized with sharply molded ribs and rivets that match prototype photos and drawings. Grab irons and ladders are factory applied separate parts. The car's underbody features separate brake components and piping.





37' 2980 Cubic-Foot 2-Bay Covered Hopper

72' Centerbeam Flatcar
